Announcement of the U18 Boys (Born 2008 or later) Team selected to participate at the Australia Youth Water Polo Championships, Brisbane, Australia, 8 – 13 April 2026

Schools Water Polo South Africa is proud to announce the selection of the national schools' water polo team that will represent South Africa at the 2026 Australia Youth Water Polo Championships, to be held in Brisbane, Australia from the 8th – 13th April 2026. The team will be departing on the 1st of April to attend training camps with Australian based coaches prior to the start of the tournament.

The team was selected following a comprehensive and rigorous selection process based on performances throughout the 2025 schools water polo season, with particular emphasis on the SA Schools Inter Provincial Tournament in December. Selectors evaluated athletes on technical ability, tactical awareness, consistency, teamwork and their demonstration of the values that underpin Schools Water Polo South Africa.

Selection to a national schools' team is both an honour and a responsibility. The chosen athletes will represent not only their schools and provinces, but also South African schools water polo on the international stage, acting as ambassadors for the sport and the country.

Schools Water Polo South Africa congratulates all selected players and extends its appreciation to the many athletes who were considered during the selection process. The depth of talent across the country continues to reflect the strength and growth of schools' water polo in South Africa.
