Mandatory Eligibility Requirement

- Applicants **must have coached or managed at the 2025 IPT in Johannesburg.**

Ideal applicants will:

- Demonstrate strong technical and tactical water polo knowledge
- Be team-focused, professional, and player-centred
- Display sound leadership, communication, and administrative skills
- Commit fully to pre-tour planning, training, and disciplinary expectations
- Promote inclusivity, sportsmanship, and the reputation of SWPSA

Responsibilities include:

- Supporting selection, preparation, and performance of touring teams
- Managing athlete welfare, logistics, communication, and safeguarding
- Always representing SWPSA professionally, both locally and abroad

- Coaching or Management CV
- IPT 2025 team and role confirmation
- Brief motivation (maximum 300 words)
